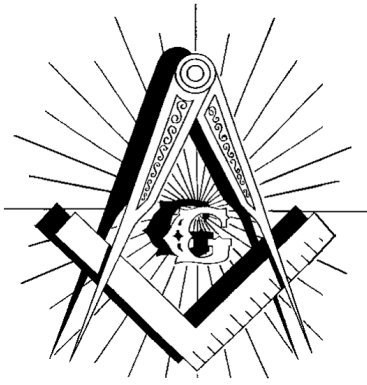


January Trestleboard
